



Visit Bend Excellence in Tourism Award

Overview

The Visit Bend Excellence in Tourism Award recognizes an organization or individual who has made an extraordinary contribution to Bend tourism including:

- Providing excellent customer service and value
- Creating a significant economic impact to the local community
- Attracting visitors from outside of the region
- Generating media attention
- Promoting Bend as a world-class tourist destination

Selection and Presentation

The award is announced and presented on an annual basis each February. Nominations close on November 1st. The award winner will be selected from among the qualified candidates by the Visit Bend Board of Directors.

Prize

The award recipient will receive \$1,000 toward Visit Bend Partner Marketing offerings including Visitor Guide and online advertising, social networking mentions, and inclusion in the Visit Bend Bend Buzz e-newsletter.

Entry Criteria

1. The award recognizes accomplishments for activities that occurred or were completed during the calendar year of entry.
2. Organizations or individuals may be self-nominated or nominated by another party.
3. Candidates must have current business operations in Bend, Oregon.
4. Past award winners may be renominated in recognition of new accomplishments.
